Simple Flash - Flash Modes

- We won't use Normal Flash because
 - The Camera decides whether to Use Flash or Not
 - We Want to Make that Decision !!
 - We will use Fill-Flash 95% of the Time
- We'll discuss Red-Eye Reduction
- We'll discuss Fast Flash
- We'll discuss Slow Sync





User-friendly Design



With magnetic accessory port to swiftly install various of accessories e.g. AK-R1 accessory kit.



Typical Symbol for Auto Flash - 400 Low Light Level Heavy Back-Lighting NOT, the Camera !!

The Camera decides whether to Use Flash or Not

We want to decide when and how to Use Flash



Flash Modes ~ Fill Flash

- Typical Symbol for Fill Flash (4) Fill-flash will <u>ALWAYS</u> fire the flash provided ... A Speedlight is attached to the camera, AND The Speedlight is turned ON. We can control ... The Amount of Flash, 0, +1,+2, -1, -2 EV (Stops) The Direction of Flash ~ Direct, Bounce, etc..



Flash Exposure

Manual

Too Complicated for this Presentation

TTL

Much Easier to Use



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Flash Exposure ~ TTL

- TTL = Through The Lens
 - Speedlite fires a micro "pre-flash"
 - Camera measures pre-flash then
 - Calculates Flash Power for Correct Exposure
 - Takes Your Shot with Correct Flash Exposure
 - All this from One Press of Your Shutter Button





Flash Exposure ~ TTL Control

- Flash Exposure Compensation
 - -1,-2,-3,+1,+2,+3 EV (Stops) of Flash Power
 - This can be set on your Flash OR
 - On Most Camera Menu Settings
 - Take a Shot at OEV then check it
 - Add or Subtract Flash Power if Needed








Use Slow Sync Flash





Your Subject Must Remain Still





Flash Modes ~ Slow Flash

- Typical Symbol for Slow Flash SLOW
- Fill-flash selects shutter speed for the flash only
- Slow Flash lengthens the shutter speed
 - The Background is Correctly Exposed
 - Foreground Objects must be careful not to move.

Use a Snoot for Dramatic Light








- SLR & DSLR Cameras have Focal Plane Shutters
- They Comprise Two Curtains that Open then Close
- At Speeds < ~ 1/250th the Curtains Open Fully</p>
- At Higher Speeds there is banding
- The Flash Exposes Only Part of the Image
- Most Cameras will Limit the Speed for Flash
- Take Care with Manual Flash







Off Camera Flash

Far Greater Control Over Position of Flash Lighting

Three Methods

Cable

- Radio Triggers

Wireless/Optical Control using Camera's Pop-Up Flash




















































Off Camera Flash - Cable





Off Camera Flash - Cable + Bracket



- The Bracket Adds Versatility
- Moves Flash away from Lens Focal Centre Reduces Red-Eye





Off Camera Flash - "Wireless"


- On-Camera Flash is the Commander TTL Flash Metering systems ONE Very Significant Issue Line of Sight
 - System must have "Line of Sight



One or more Off-Camera Speedlights are Slaves

Canon, Nikon, Olympus, Sony and others have





Off Camera Flash - "Wireless" = "Optical"

Requires Direct Line of Sight between Camera and Remote Flash







XProO TTL Wireless Flash Trigger can control the flashes with built-in Godox wireless X system e.g. camera flashes, outdoor flashes and studio flashes. Featuring multi-channel triggering and stable signal transmission, this flash trigger applies to hotshoe-mounted Olympus/Panasonic series cameras.

Reliable operation up to 100 meters Camera to Flash

Off Camera Flash - "Wireless" = "Radio"









Off Camera Flash - "Radio"

- On-Camera Radio is the Commander TTL Flash Metering Other Manufacturers & OEMs have Systems
- I think this is the best method
